Old Business

- Linking Committee Report: It was the consensus of the committee to go with the following equipment to link the New Boston and the Texarkana repeaters.
- RLC6 Deluxe Controller 6 port capability Steve Stevens (W5YME) stated that they had some VHF radios that could be used as well.
- Richard Arthur made a motion to accept the findings of the committee, seconded by Robert Bailey, and to proceed with the purchase of the RLC controller.
