Karen gave a good description of the problem and several folks commented on it.

WX5CSS asked for help tuning some duplexers; K1ENT volunteered his time and effort to do it.

KF5VWN Arthur mentioned an autoresponder function he had in place on an email from the website.

Someone asked about a Technician license class. Discussion followed about the classed that had been happening in Atlanta over the past few months.
