

Here is the rotation for net control. This is subject to change and most the time without notice! If you cannot fulfill your duties on your night, please contact the next weeks' net control operator.





Newsletter to Junk Mail

If you are not getting this newsletter, this article won't do you any good!! (That's like saying "stand up if you're not here"). If you are getting the newsletter but repeatedly going to junk mail, then read on!

Depending on your email client you may have an option to change this behavior. The Microsoft Outlook client has this option. Simply right mouse click on the newsletter, look in Junk Mail, select Junk / Never Block Sender or Never Block Senders Domain or you may try Never Block this Group. It may say Add To Safe Senders List. There may be some other option that will work to.

IDSS Forecast Point Page (www.weather.gov/forecastpoints) At this link, you can get forecast information for a user identified point anywhere in your county or parish on a day-by-day, hour-by-hour basis. The interface is pretty self-explanatory, but you can get a world of forecast information for your location with just a few clicks. This is a great tool if you have outdoor activities and would like to know when the best chances for rain are during the day/night along with specific temperature information during a specified timeframe.
	Graphical Hazardous Weather Outlook (https://www.weather.gov/erh/ghwo?wfo=shv) This experimental page is a decision support service for your situational awareness that supports preparedness and response efforts prior to and during hazardous weather. This service provides decision makers with convenient access to potential weather hazard information by graphically depicting the risk of weather hazards out through seven days.
